Cause & Effect Cards Ch. 7-12

Copy the cards and laminate them for durability, if you wish. Cut out the Cause and Effect Cards and spread them out, face up on a table. Students take turns selecting and reading a Cause Card (Mowgli with monkeys). Then they match it to the corresponding Effect Card (Baloo with monkeys). The player with the most correct answers wins the game.
