Copy the Question Cards and laminate them for durability, if you wish. Cut out the Question Cards and place them on the Gameboard. Each player rolls a die and moves the appropriate number of spaces. When players land on a space with a picture, they pick a card. When players answer the question, they receive one point. The winner is the first player to reach Finish with the most points. Students can play the game several times for additional practice.
