Copy the Question Cards and laminate them for durability, if you wish. Cut out the Question Cards and place them on the Game Board. Each player rolls a die and moves the appropriate number of spaces. When players land on a space with an "X" mark, they must pick a card. Players must provide a correct answer in order to receive one point. The winner is the first player to reach the Finish with the most points. Students can play the game several times for additional practice.
