

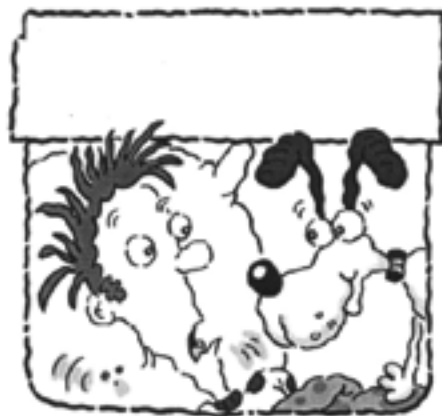
Dr. Little Comic Book

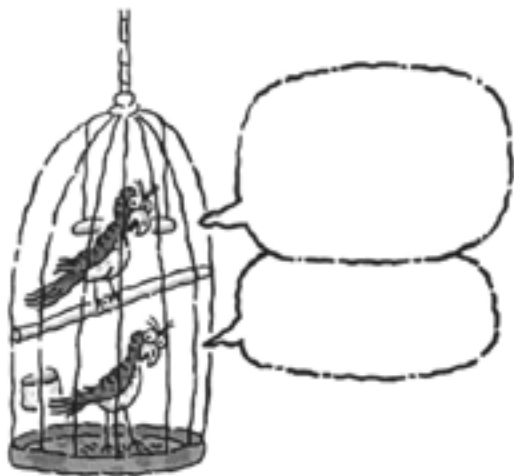
